In this study an attempt was made to find out the level of occupational stress among the teachers who work in various degree colleges of Kokrajhar district. It has been found that majority of the teachers have experienced moderate level of stress. Among 250 teachers, 127 teachers (50.8%) have occupational stress. Pupil misbehaviour, lack of work appraisal, unhealthy staff relation, time pressure, too much paper work etc. have been identified as source of their stress. The investigator has achieved the objectives posed for the study.

13. ACHIEVEMENTS FROM THE PROJECT:

right direction. The investigator has offered some implementable suggestions which if implemented properly would go a long way in improving the working environment of educational institutions. Efforts should be made to reduce the effect of occupational stress which ultimately induces the teachers to provide efficient and effective service to the society. The most important benefit in reducing occupational stress in that it will promote a pleasurable work environment for all. Such environment is very much essential for all which offers tremendous opportunity for everyone to become efficient and productive member of our society.

15. CONTRIBUTION TO THE SOCIETY (GIVE DETAILS):

Teachers play an extraordinarily important role in shaping the future of students for a better nation. For that reason, teachers-the backbone of our society needs to remain in a safe and better position. It is therefore, necessary to identify the factors which might further deplete the strength of teaching community. The objective of making our country a developed one cannot be fulfilled unless the teachers are satisfied and free from stresses and strains. This study was conducted to know the level of stress among the college teachers of Kokrajhar district. By examining the stress levels of college teachers, one can better recognize the early signs of stress which may further lead to burnout and take measures to prevent it. This study also sheds light on the relationship between teachers' occupation stress and their job satisfaction. It is expected that this study will help the administrators to learn more about the organizational behavior so that they may be able to improve the job conditions and bring a direct benefit to teachers. It may be mentioned that any kind of study can be considered fruitful and effective which helps us to know the current status and condition of teacher for betterment of our society.

The findings of the study are expected to help the teaching community to excel in their effectiveness and efficiency in job situation. Nobody can deny the harmful effects of stress on the individual and society. So it is necessary to provide conductive environment and support to each and every one to overcome the negative effects of stress. In order to maintain mental health of the teacher and student, various measures should be taken by making use of different management strategies at regular intervals or by providing effective guidance and counseling. At the same time various programmes like workshops, seminars and periodical stress management programmes needed to be organized among the teachers. Further, some major points should be taken care by the authority to improve organization climate that is, supervision, support and relationship with the teachers' need to be corrected and enhanced most strongly.

14. SUMMARY OF THE FINDINGS (IN 500 WORDS):

Now-a-days teaching community has found to be one of the stressful occupations. The increasing workload on teachers, the multiple roles, and the increased class size against one teacher and an increasing number of pupil misbehaviour are some of the trends which accelerate the level of stress among the teachers.
